**Club Program**: Tim Richardson introduced the guest speaker, Matt Trantham. Matt and his wife Cristina are Captains and are the local Salvation Army Corps Officers. Matt said that the Salvation Army (SA) is the oldest non-profit in Fayetteville. The SA provides homeless shelter service on a first come and first serve basis, extra Emergency Shelter during freezing conditions and Love Lunches and Dinners. Currently the SA provides shelter for 55 at their facilities and 22 family members at local Motels. The main shelter space was recently flooded by Hurricane Mathew creating difficulty for the local SA. The SA also has a Thrift Store, a Community Center with programs and assistance through its Social Services Office. SA also provides after school and summer programs and weekly senior citizens programs.
