Report: President Catherine:

- 1: Three district wards at District Conference. The only club with three awards out of 18 awards at District level - Interact award, Rotaract Award and Public Relations single event award for our Black Tie dinner
- 2: Youth and Community (for RDA) - two highly commended Awards at District Level.
- 3: 60th celebration for Burleigh Heads Lions – a table on 26 May at BHSLSLSC acceptances to Catherine

Guest speaker

Lance Edbrooke, Local Chaplaincy Committee, Miami High School

- 1: Lance opened with a video of some successful clients of Chaplains in State Schools in Queensland especially in relation to youth self harm
- 2: 600 Chaplains in Queensland state education system
- 3: The Miami High Chaplain was appointed in 2007
- 4: Since then there has been no extra funding for the position
- 5: The next Federal Government funding review takes place in 2018. We are working with these government agencies for a funding increase
- 6: Miami High's costs have increased by \$10,000 though last year we finished in surplus with \$1800 in credit
- 7: We are confident that we will have strong local support for a full time position
- 8: We are pleased to partner with our school executives and P&C Associations.
- 9: We seek further financial support for the project from RCBH in any way possible
- 10: A precedent for such support exists - the iconic Miami High Sign was partly funded by voluntary work from RCBH members

President Catherine indicated that we may be able to best support the Miami High LCC through the Miami High Interact Club into the future.
