SPEAKER

Tracey from Lombok Heroes was our speaker today. Tracey lived and worked in Bali for 5 years running her own B&B and where she met Peter Honey and his wife who were shocked to see disabled, sick and dying children who had no help whatsoever. From this spark was born Lombok Forgotten Children- Endri Foundation. Mission priorities being no child in pain, free surgery, stop the suffering, grow more endri's, drive change, fundraise. Lombok Heroes was set up for relocating locals to where the food was and helping people build their homes (rather than live in tents in these rehab areas) after the earthquake. The volunteers help people understand how to build .. how to get obtain tools and use them so that they don't live as long time refugees. They would learn to use the existing pad of the destroyed homes and clear it up and build new structures (homes) on these. All this is done at a grassroots level and using, training and empowering the locals to better their own lives and the lives of their community.
