Guest speaker – Allan on “ My Great Uncle Hugh, POW WW2

I did not have as much time as I would have liked and while it was an “ ANZAC theme” sorry if it was an unhappy story but I wanted to tell it how it was in war, and as I said Hugh was not a hero but just an ordinary but unlucky soldier that gave his life so that we may enjoy the life we have today. What I did want to tell, but did not have time, is that while Hugh was suffering as a POW, his brother, my grandfather stayed at home as he had three very young daughters (one my Mum) but he profited from the war. He and my grandmother ran a Café in Deniliquin and a US Air base was established there, they told me they sold thousands of plates of steak, eggs and chips to the US soldiers. Now I have always got the impression they may have felt guilty about this over the years, but that is war and life. I was very close to them and they were both very kind, generous and wonderful people. My grandfather was a Lions Club member for about 30 years, self employed his entire life, worked until he was 82 and died at 93.
