Guest Speaker: Helen Bo Morse on Disaster Aid Australia.

This started in 2010 as a Water Project, since then the business model has changed to Disaster Aid Australia. The Sky Hydrant is the star of the show, with Bo showing a great video on how they work. Basically they weigh only 18kg, very portable, less than a metre high, and can filter 100,000L of clean drinking water a day! This is enough for 500 people. They last for years and are relatively maintenance free. One current project is in Bhutan, where they are distributing 500 filters, one for every school in Bhutan, using Global Grants.

Clean water is a basic human right. Lots of interesting questions from our members, and a great guest speaker session. Thank you by Bren
