## Guest Speaker: Jodie Burden from Animal Welfare League Queensland.

This organisation in the field of animal welfare. AWLQ was started way back in 1959 by a group of concerned citizens who were appalled at the treatment of abandoned family pets. The solution of this problem was to take them to the local pound and shot. Since then AWLQ has cared for over 15000 animals every year across the 5 pounds and shelters across SE Queensland. Their policy is never to turn away any animal in need, regardless of the owners circumstances. They have achieved zero euthanasia and the highest save rate in Australia as they care for their animals for as long as it takes them to get rehomed. Often they make a loss on every rehome as they health assess, desex, vaccinate and microchip all animals with vets on site.

AWLQ also runs education programs in schools and the for the general community on the importance of responsible pet care. One of the programs they have is the Golden Hearts program. Member benefits include Pet Matching for seniors looking to adopt, Short Term Emergency Pet care Service, Legacy Pets Program which helps with a Forever Foster home with a loving adoptive family and will always be under the care and protection of the AWLQ.

This presentation was very interesting and we learned a lot of new things that the AWLQ is involved in. This must be one of the few organisations that would be pleased to announce that they were no longer.
