PDG Trevor Taylor - Member Behind the Badge

Trevor Taylor - PDG Sunshine Coast and member of our club.

- Over his time with Rotary mainly worked in Solomon Island, Peru on International projects
- Life History -
- Born in Roma
- Trevor has been a farmer all his life - originally cattle, sheep and also small crops
- Schooled at home through correspondence - 3 days of school and then on horseback for the rest of the time (proper)
- Called up for National Service and spent 364 days in Vietnam. Was definitely a life changing and interesting experience and was of course happy to return to Australia
- Met and married (46 ½ years later - still together)
- Left Roma and bought a farm on Sunshine Coast. From here moved onto a few farms throughout the years.
- Dabbled in real estate a little (12 years)
- People often said - I'm too busy to join Rotary but he always had time for Rotary
- Was a member Surfers Paradise club
- Cattle farm out at Canungra
- Been to Thailand, Nauru, Fiji, Solomon Islands - about 32-34 trips over the last 12 years - been a long and interesting time doing work with these people - schools and medical centre to improve the facilities
- Work on these projects with a number of other Rotary Clubs all around Australia - Trevor has offered assistance and advice for other clubs so they can coordinate their projects in these countries.
- Sold his farm to move to the Gold Coast
