Guest speaker

Our guest speaker was Steve Stuttle from 4CRB Radio Station - they are a community station and needs a reason for operating. They were the first station on the GC and have operated since March 1984. Target Market is 50+ Audience and they send a Christian Gospel Message via 1 in every 6 songs and in addition have a few segments during the week christian focused.

Music played is 50's and 60's. They promote non profit charities with our Scooter project being one of them.

Number of listeners is 40-50,000/week and they are a loyal audience. 4CRB have had their licence renewed for another 5 Years. They rely on Sponsors and supporters for funding. Sponsors are for example: Jenny from HelloWorld Travel and Catherine from My Jewellery Shop.

Supporters are 4000-5000 people per year who donate money to the station. Last year raised \$227,000 from Supporters. The station operates on a 1 million turnover. The future of radio is Digital Radio coming next year where you can pause, rewind digital radio and 4CRB would have additional channels. They have signed with Channel 7 to broadcast the local news. Channel 7 have the broadcast rights for the Commonwealth Games. The station needs to look to the future by continuing to look into new technology. Bren's wife Sue is a regular announcer who volunteers at the station. Tune into 89.3 for some 50's and 60's easy listening!

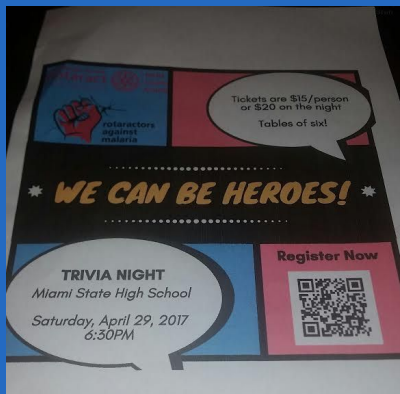
Around the District and beyond
