- Predominantly staffed by volunteers
- Help build a better future for those on the coast
- Provide essential services to improve the quality of life

Mission

- to love, care for, support and inspire those in our community who are in genuine need or who are hurting.
 - To provide pathways and support for individuals who are facing difficulties, in order for them to become valued members of our community
- What are the issues and why do people struggle?
 - Ongoing affordable housing shortage
 - People who struggle to find work and place to rent
 - Family issues are creating
 - High unemployment
 - Families who experienced trauma and death of loved one who are struggling

What are we doing?

Over 250 families with food are currently being supported.

- Crisis Care
 - Offer frozen cooked meals, food hampers, vouchers, clothing and goods, offer assistance for payment of medical bills, utilities or rent. Also offer short courses - how to break the cycle and get back on track
- Rescue One
 - Offers home maintenance service to assist with burdensome household tasks.
- Counselling Psychology
 - On-site personalized assistance which includes mediation to address issues of anxiety, depression, marriage and relational difficulties, parenting, grief and loss, also counselling, therapy and transformational programs
- WEx Program
 - Work experience initiative run in conjunction with local employment agencies
- Community Education
 - Delivery of support services, money management, drug proof your kids, family foundations, life skill courses
- Mothers Heart - to assist those with post-natal depression.
- Work for the Dole initiatives - as well as return to work program
- Opportunity shop
- Community Events - during peak festive times as community fundraisers (family fun days)
