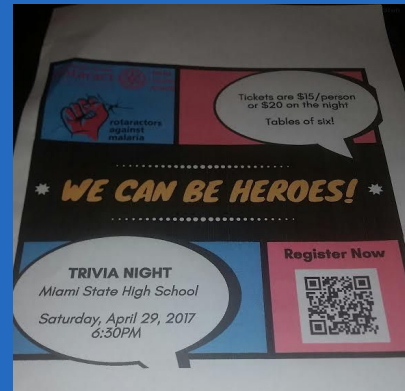

Our guest speaker was Erica Morgante from Home Instead who not only left us some very informative leaflets, but spoke about the options of relatives going into care and what the options are. In essence if you or someone you know is seeking home help you need to register for an assessment T 1800 200 422 for an assessment (which can take some time, but some help can be given whilst you are waiting for assessment).

The company HomeInstead.com.au is able to offer senior or disabled care (no age limit); dementia and palliative care. Erica spoke of the 4 levels of care and what single and couples may be eligible to receive to enable them to stay at home. Erica's talk also highlighted the various booklets Home Instead provides to advise both carers and potential carers of relatives who may be in need of help at home from the basic level of help and upwards.
