

# 2016 / 2017 CLUB GOALS.

## WHEELCHAIR PROJECT.

The wheelchair project is the only continuous international project in the district and the heart for RC Surfers Sunrise. To continue the support and raise greater awareness of the project, we aim to achieve the following:

1. Hold at least 2 Wheelchair Working Bees.
2. Introduce a ReCycle Programme for discarded bicycles.
3. Commit to a Flatpack School Project.
4. Pledge 50% of fundraising funds to be directed towards the Wheelchair Project.

## YOUTH.

RC Surfers Sunrise has a proud history of supporting an array of youth programs. This year we aim to support the following youth programs and will seek candidates for:

1. National Youth Science Forum (NYSF) candidate in January 2017.
