
Gabo Island: 1955 - 1962

Engineering of the rotating light

• The huge glass lens needed to spin continuously; floated in a circular trough of mercury.

Why Mercury:

- High density,
- Non-wetting to metals
- Self-leveling:
- No lubrication required:
- highly toxic.
- the light used kerosene and vapour burners — highly flammable stuff.



Construction

- Gabo Island Lighthouse was designed by Alexander Dawson
- Stevenson family of Scotland —

•

• The black sheep of the family was Robert Louis Stevenson who wrote Treasure Island.

• The entire lighthouse (completed 1862) was constructed from pink granite quarried right on the island; — one of the reasons it's so distinctive. Plus the stone is hard.



Wilson Promontory: 1961 - 1967

- It's one of the oldest lighthouses in Victoria
- It marks the southernmost point of mainland Australia
- The Prom is notorious for gales, lightning, and rough seas.

- Stunningly beautiful
- Extreme winds
- Very rough seas
- Ran out of water
- LOTS of snakes





- Sir Francis Chichester's famous solo circumnavigation of the globe in 1966–1967, aboard his yacht, the Gipsy Moth IV.
- We reported to the ABC radio we had spotted him. Turned out it was a very big freight ship!!!

- 1905: An incandescent kerosene mantle—increasing the brightness to 100,000 candles.
- 1939: diesel generator, increasing the brightness to 1 million candles.
- 1962: electricity.
