#### WHAT MAY THIS SUPPORT LOOK LIKE?

- THE PURCHASE OF NEW SCHOOL UNIFORMS (OR EXTRA CLOTHING / SHOES)
- THE PURCHASE OF LEARNING MATERIALS (SPORTS GEAR, SPECIAL DEVICES, ETC)
- SUPPORT OR PART SUPPORT TO ATTEND EVENTS / ACTIVITIES THAT ARE BEYOND THE FAMILY'S MEANS
- SPECIAL FEES TO PROVIDE EXTRA LEARNING SUPPORT FOR A STUDENT
- BREAKFAST CLUB / LUNCH CLUB SUPPORT
- ETC, ETC





#### THE PROCESS:

- 1. MEET WITH SCHOOL PRINCIPAL/S. EXPLAIN THE PROGRAM. LEAVE AN INFO SHEET AT THE SCHOOL/S.
- 2. STUDENT/S REQUIREMENT IS <u>IDENTIFIED BY THE SCHOOL PRINCIPAL</u> WHO NOTIFIES THE ROTARY CLUB OF WHAT IS NEEDED. NOTE: **NO FAMILY DETAILS ARE GIVEN TO THE ROTARY CLUB**.
- 3. THE ROTARY CLUB THEN LOOKS AT ALL REQUESTS AND, IF APPROPRIATE, APPROVES AN AMOUNT.
- 4. THE PRINCIPAL (OR DELEGATE) ORGANISES THE PURCHASE OR PROVISION AND THEN NOTIFIES ROTARY.
- 5. THE MONEY IS THEN TRANSFERRED TO THE SCHOOL. (MONEY IS NEVER TRANSFERRED TO THE FAMILY)
- 6. REPEAT AS NEEDED

• THE ROTARY CLUB ( PROMOTE AND FUND )

THE LOCAL SCHOOL/S (IDENTIFY AND IMPLEMENT)

SAFE FUNDS MOVE DIRECTLY FROM ROTARY ACCOUNT TO SCHOOL ACCOUNT
