ZOOM BASICS for Success in Joining Rotary Club of Mission Viejo Zoom Meetings

There are 3 ways you can join the Rotary Club of Mission Viejo zoom meeting:

- 1. Direct your web browser to https://zoom.us/j/412537313 and follow the instructions.
- 2. Install the Zoom app on your smartphone. Enter Meeting ID 412537313 and click "Join Meeting".
- 3. Call (669) 900-9128. When prompted enter Meeting ID 412537313 then #. Some things to keep in mind: If you are using a computer:
- a. You must have a camera and microphone installed to participate with video. Most modern laptops and Macs have them, desktop pc's usually do not.
- b. The first time you connect to Zoom it will install an app. Go ahead and say 'yes' to download and run.
- c. To access settings move your mouse to the bottom of the window to unhide the control ribbon.
  - d. Keep yourself muted when you are not speaking to minimize background noise for other participants.

If you are using a smartphone:

- a. Go to the app store or Google Play store and search for "Zoom". The icon will look like a white video camera inside a blue circle
- b. Download and install the app.
- c. Open the app and click "Join"
- d. Enter Meeting ID 412537313 for your meeting
- e. Swipe left to access more settings
- 3. If you are dialing in on a phone:
  - a. Mute and unmute your audio like you would for a regular phone call on your phone.
