MV Rotary Donates \$2600 to the Door of Faith Orphanage!

At the December 11, 2013 meeting of the Rotary Club of Mission Viejo, **Dr. Richard Frieder**, Co-Director of International Service for the Club, presented a check in the amount of \$2,600.20 to Director D.J. Schuetze, of the Door of Faith Orphanage in Baja, Mexico. The donation will help the Orphanage staff provide Christmas gifts for the 120 children in their care.

This donation marks the 20th year the Rotary Club of Mission Viejo has supported the orphanage. In addition to providing funds and/or gifts for the children's Christmas, the club has provided annual eye exams, and glasses as needed, to the children and staff for the past two decades, as well. The club sends a team to the orphanage led by **Dr. Richard Freider.** The team includes **Dr. Aaron Sako and staff from La Paz Optometric in Laguna Hills, Dr. Pushpa Chandwani** and other Rotary members and friends.

Additional support is given the orphanage throughout the year, as well. For example: 1) the club helped purchase the school uniforms needed by the children to attend public school in Mexico; 2) the club helped purchase a newer van used for transporting children to school, church, and community service projects; and more.

On Wednesday, December 4, 2013, we had an excellent program on the Importance of Fatherhood presented by Maria Crockett. She gave some rather startling statistics on fatherless homes. For example:

- Four times as likely to live in poverty.
- More likely to have behavioral problems.
- At higher risk of domestic violence.
- More likely to go prison.
- More likely to commit crimes.
- Seven times as likely to get pregnant as a teen.
- 120% more likely to be endangered by some type of child abuse and neglect.
- 68% move likely to smoke and to abuse substances including alchol and drugs
- Nine times as likely to drop out of school.

She then had a volunteer, Scott Walker, come up and we were all given a sheet of positive words and when Scott closed his eyes we went around the



room saying one of the positive words in three minutes. When it was over Scott felt much better about himself. This just reinforced her theme of hearing positive things rather than negative statements all the time. She then had Dennis O'Connor tell a story about his childhood. She repeated the story with a positive spin on it and Dennis felt she told the story better than he had. Once again positive influence.

She felt that we all have a responsibility to help by being positive in our conclusions about people.

Truly a very positive program for this, or any, time of year.
