Mr. Marquez explained that IEC programs include intense 8 to 9 months programs in vocational areas of: automotive technology, business office services, computer systems, criminal justice, dental assistant, medical assistant, and pharmacy technician, and more.

The programs costs are approximately \$18,000 for a typical 8 to 9 month program. The school is proud of the approximately 70% placement rate for the students and has been in business for 35 years.
