With just enough clean water to cook and drink, children in the village of our most recent International project did not brush their teeth regularly and had little hope for lasting good dental hygiene.

Thank you in part to funding through The Rotary Foundation (TRF) and co-sponsored by the Rotary Club of Mission Viejo, the project school site now has new sinks and clean water. With the new sinks and purified water, the school has started the children in a daily brushing routine! One child exclaimed, “Now we can brush our teeth!”

In addition, volunteer dentists are supporting the project by providing much needed dental care.
