Evan shared his background, his scholarship application, and his long-range goals. By the time Evan was 14 both of his parents were deceased. However, he was motivated to succeed. He was able to complete a strong educational base while in his home of Taiwan and when the opportunity to apply for a Rotary Ambassadorial Scholarship presented itself, he made application.

After acceptance, he moved to the U.S. and is hosted by the Rotary Club of Encinitas Coastal. Although he holds Master of Arts Degrees in three areas, Evan is continuing his education at UCLA and UCSD and is a Ph.D. candidate.

His long-range goals is to become a university professor.

Orange County DA Tony Rackauckas

Rotary Club of Mission Viejo, the guest speaker was Orange County District Attorney Tony Rackauckas

Mr. Rackauckas began by sharing details of his background. He is a 1971 graduate of Loyola School of Law and served terms as a Municipal Judge and a Superior Court Judge during the 1990s. He is currently serving his fourth term of office as Orange County's District Attorney.

Mr. Rackauckas then shared some details of the Orange County DA's office. The Orange County District Attorney's office consists of approximately 800 employees. Within that number there are approximately 250 Deputy District Attorneys and 170 Investigators. The office deals with approximately 80,000 cases a year. 25,000 are felony cases.

Mr. Rackauckas told the audience that the two most significant changes in fighting crime in Orange County include the development and use of the 1) Orange County District Attorney Office www.orangecountyda.com DNA Data Base and 2) OC Gang Reduction www.missionviejorotary.org.

During the March 5, 2014 meeting of the Intervention Partnership (OC GRIP). As the name implies, the DNA Data Base is used to help identify criminals and the OC GRIP program has been highly successful in deterring and/or prosecuting gang members in violation of California laws.
