

## DOWN THE YEARS

A look at Rotary from the memory of longtime member, PP George Cooper, PHF. Over more than 60 years, George has been a member of four clubs: Syracuse, NY, Rotary/One Chicago, IL. Mount Prospect, IL and currently, Mission Viejo, CA.

#### I JOINED ROTARY AND DISCOVERED MYSELF

My adventure with Rotary started over 60 years ago...November 26, 1954..to be exact. It was a few weeks earlier that a stock broker, whose off ice was across from mine, asked me to lunch. He said he wanted to take me some where I would find enjoyment. I was game and a way we went to the Onondaga Hotel and a lunch where 446 members of the Rotary Club of Syracuse, N.Y. met weekly.

I was impressed...I joined lunch with some of the top members of the community including CEO's, A Salvation Army General, a top brain surgeon, the coach of Syracuse University, bankers, business owners etc. I was representing an envelope company at the time and my first thought was not of service but "here was a gold mine of business ready to be sold!".

I became a member and the next thing I knew instead of dragging in orders, I was dragging a Christmas tree to an orphanage with the help of my oldest son and a truck donated by a Rotarian. A little later I found myself as a greeter where I learned to announce visitors in to a microphone (we sometimes had 15 or more). This was my first experience with public speaking. Later I found myself learning carpentry by joining fellow Rotarians in building a day camp for crippled children and thus helped found this day camp called Rippling Rhythm farms...60 acres in historic Chittenango Valley. We called it Camp Good Will.

By then, I long forgot about "getting business" But it came to me anyway because I was an active Rotarian. When walking downtown, many a Rotarian would greet me with "Hi George," by the way stop by my office.

But most important, I discovered my real reason for being a Rotarian and I discovered what I really was all about.
