California Commission on Judicial Performance

Mr. Michael Moodian, Ph.D., presented to the Rotary Club of Mission Viejo at the regularly scheduled meeting on November 13, 2019. Mr. Moodian is a commission member on the California Commission on Judicial Performance. The Commission reviews complaints towards, and has jurisdiction over, all active and former California judges.

The Commission is made up of three judges, two public members appointed by the State Assembly Speaker, Public members appointed by State Senate Rules Committee, two attorneys appointed by the State Governor, and two public members appointed by the State Governor.

The Commission reviews complaints, typically each seven week, and each complaint has a conclusion presented by the Commission. The conclusions include one of the following: 1) Dismiss; 2) Advisory letter; 3) Private admonishment; 4) Public admonishment; 5) Public censure; 6) Removal; or 7) Involuntary retirement.

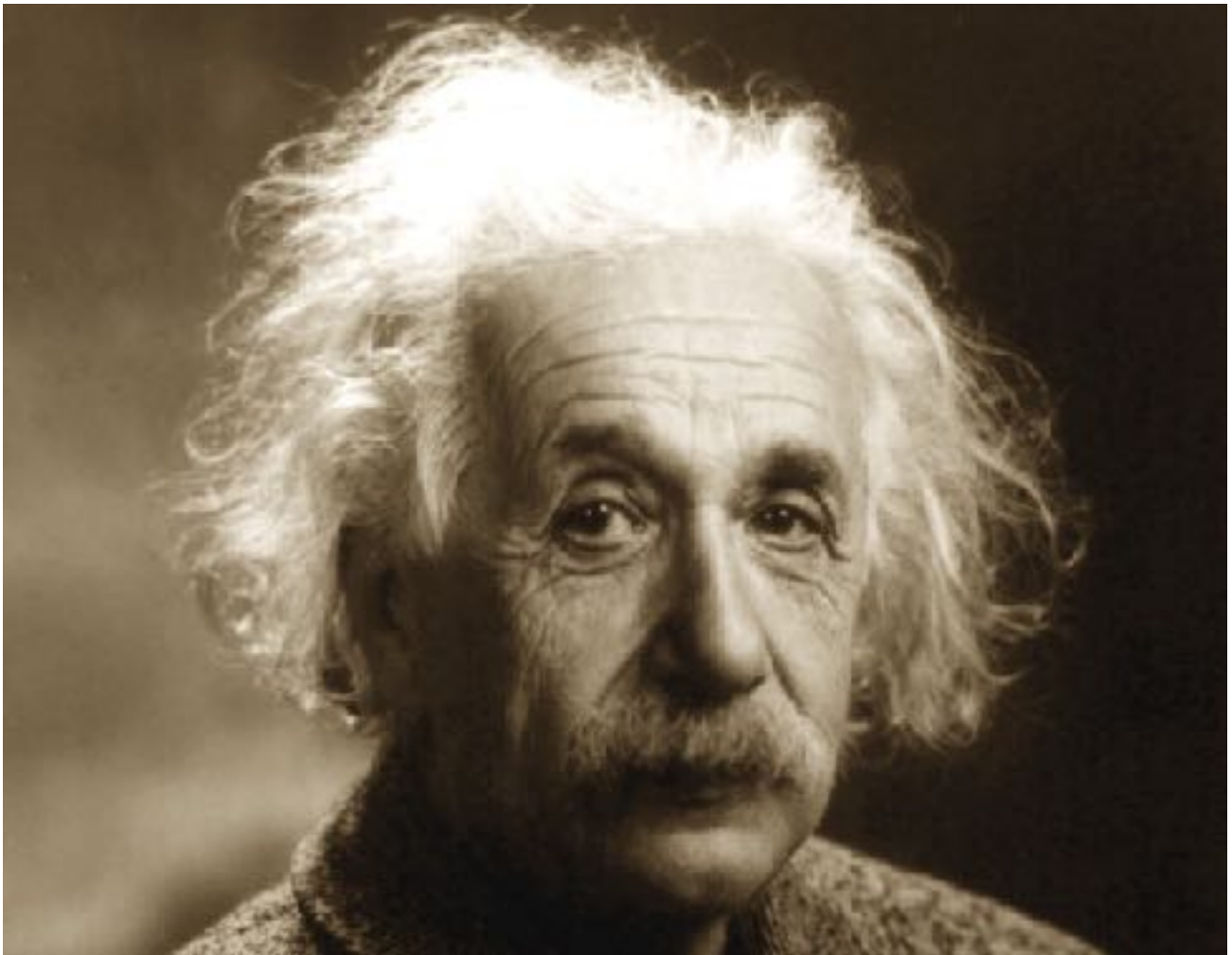
