Over the past 5 decades Bud co-founded IVV, built a clinic, guest housing and a hospital, trained staff, performed surgeries, recruited volunteers, and much more. This is no simple feat. There are more than 20 tribes in Zambia, alone - and many different tribal languages.

The MV club is delighted to have Bud as a member. Most recently, Dr. Pushpa Chandwani accompanied Bud on a medical mission and he hopes others can do the same.
