San Diego Community Power (SDCP) is a Community Choice Aggregator (CCA) committed to providing municipalities, businesses, and residents in the cities of Chula Vista, Encinitas, Imperial Beach, La Mesa, San Diego, National City and unincorporated San Diego County with clean, renewable energy at competitive rates and investing in innovative programs that benefit the environment and the economy in our communities.

SDCP, a not-for-profit public agency, began purchasing renewable-focused electricity on behalf of municipal and business customers in 2021. This year, it is extending service to residential customers, enrolling Chula Vista residents in May. SDG&E will continue to deliver the power, manage monthly billing and customer service, and provide ongoing power system maintenance.

Sebastian Sarria is the Program and Policy Manager for San Diego Community Power. He's played an integral in the formation of the organization, serving as part of the initial team since pre-launch. He works to ensure that programs are developed with the community's input in mind. He also works on the regulatory and legislative team addressing priorities for the organization. Sebastian holds a Master of Public Policy from UC San Diego and a Bachelor of Arts in Political Science from the University of Central Florida.

He serves on the Climate Action Campaign Board of Directors and was recently recognized as San Diego Business Journal's 2021 Next Top Business Leader Under 40. Sebastian will give an overview of cleaner energy choices, competitive electricity rates managed by the people who use it, and programs that benefit you.

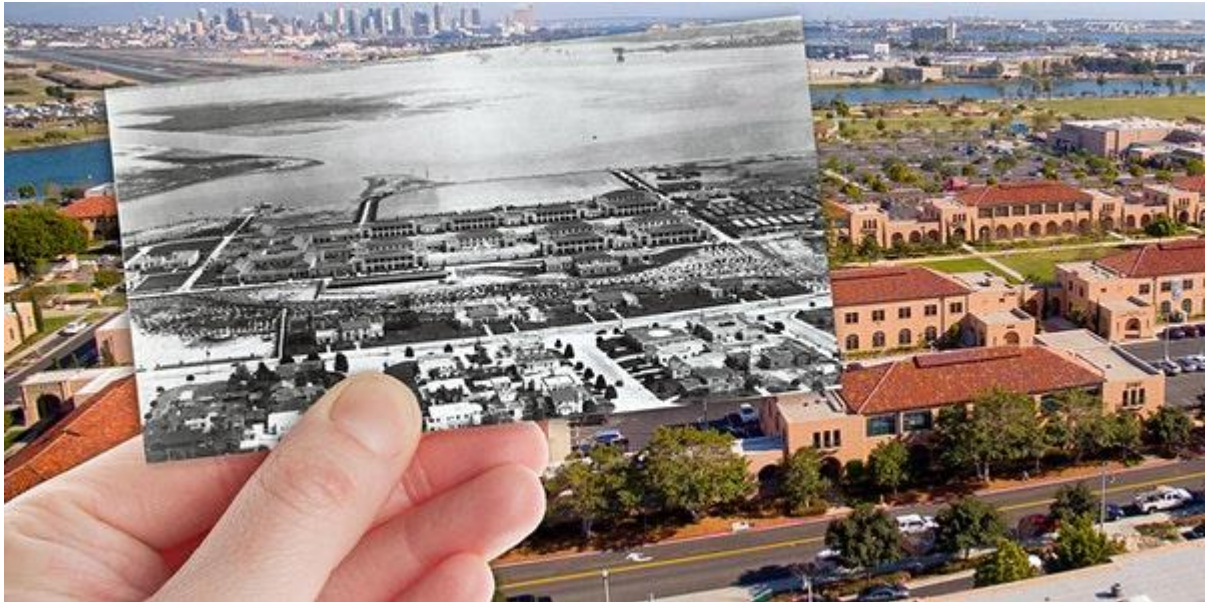

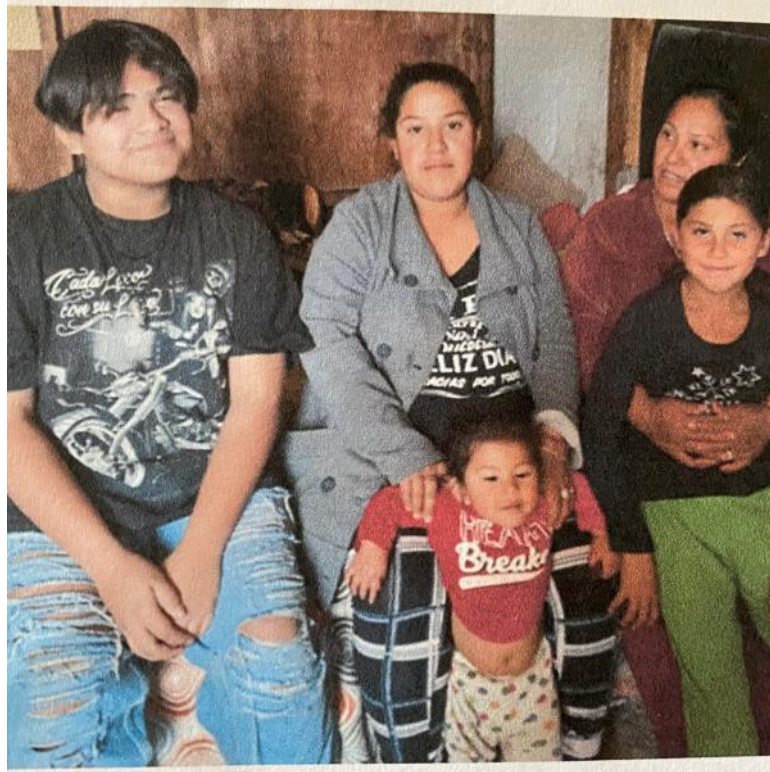
