Marlon also serves as the Emergency operations Center Director, facilitating a coordinated response among all agencies.

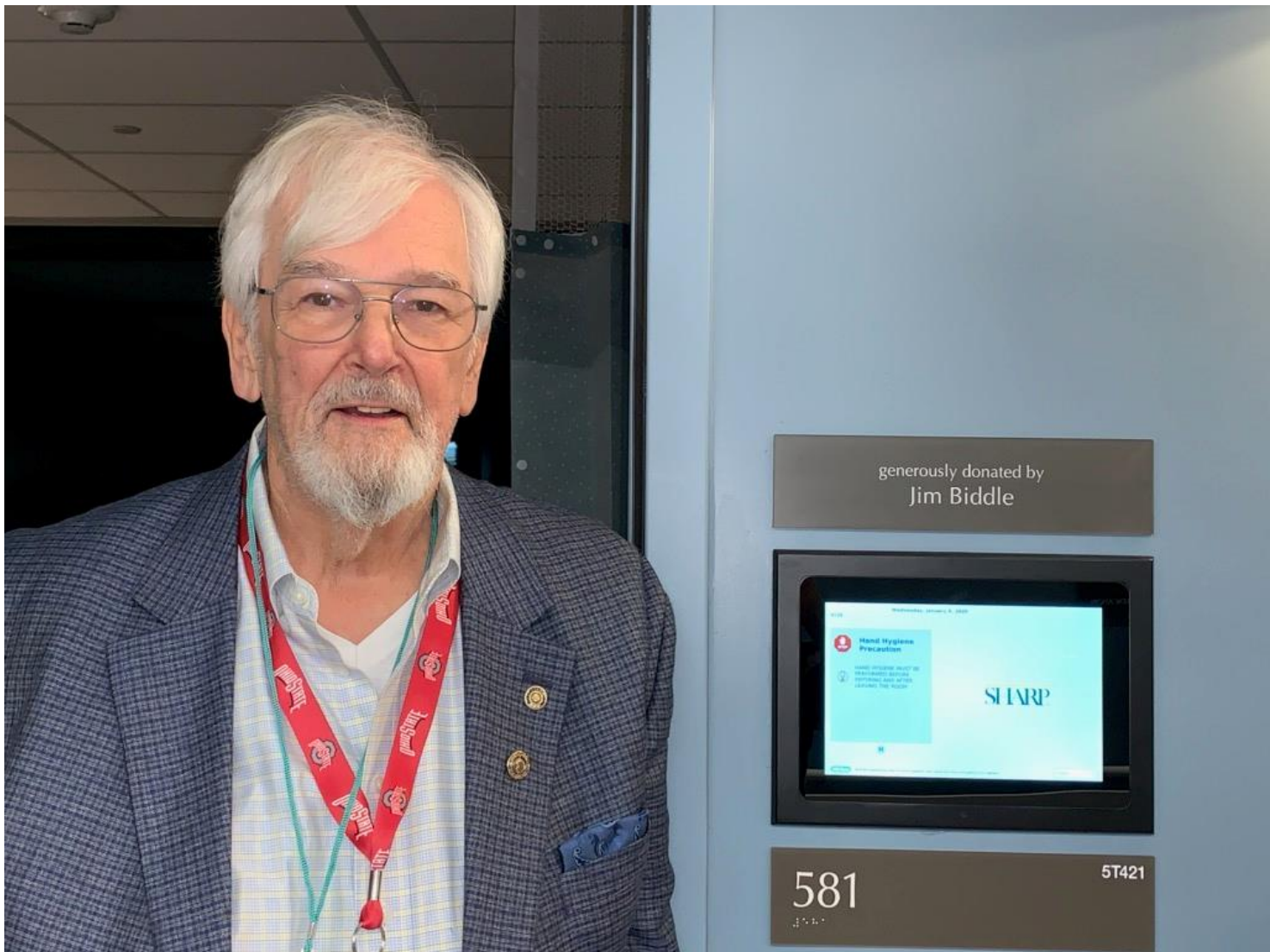
Previously, Marlon served in a similar capacity at the County of San Diego and was a consultant with SAIC.

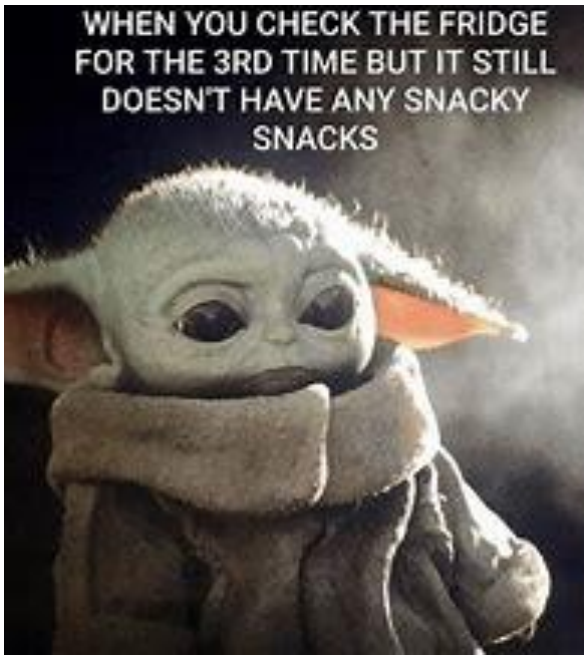
