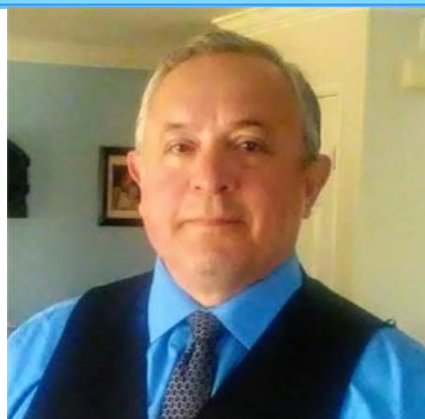

Guest Speaker: Jose Cruz
San Diego Council on Literacy



Jose Cruz is the chief executive officer for the San Diego Council on Literacy, a model urban literacy coalition. He has 34 years of experience in the literacy field and is in his 13th year as his organization's CEO. He is the recipient of the 2003 Union-Tribune, "Educator of the Year" award, past-president of the National Alliance of Urban Literacy Coalitions, and past-president of the San Diego Branch of the Orton Dyslexia Society.

In 2014, he was recognized by The Union-Tribune as the Latino Civic Leader of the Year. He currently serves as a board officer for ProLiteracy, the largest literacy organization in the world, and is the host of wsRadio's "Literacy For All Radio Show", which is broadcast live from San Diego to support literacy efforts across the nation.

Jose will share the work of the San Diego Council on Literacy:

- Documenting the state of literacy in the San Diego region.
- Instilling the importance of literacy in the region.
- Increasing impact of services through coordinated community-scaled efforts.
- Filling services gaps via initiatives and support to SDCOL affiliated literacy programs.

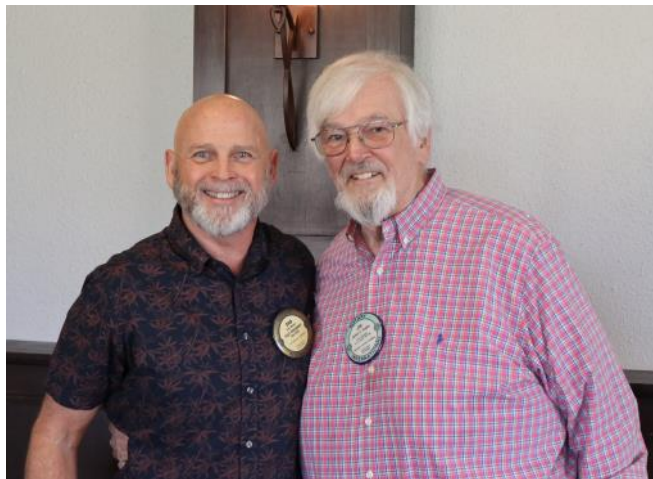
