Job well done and very entertaining! Kudos for your bravery. (See photos next page).

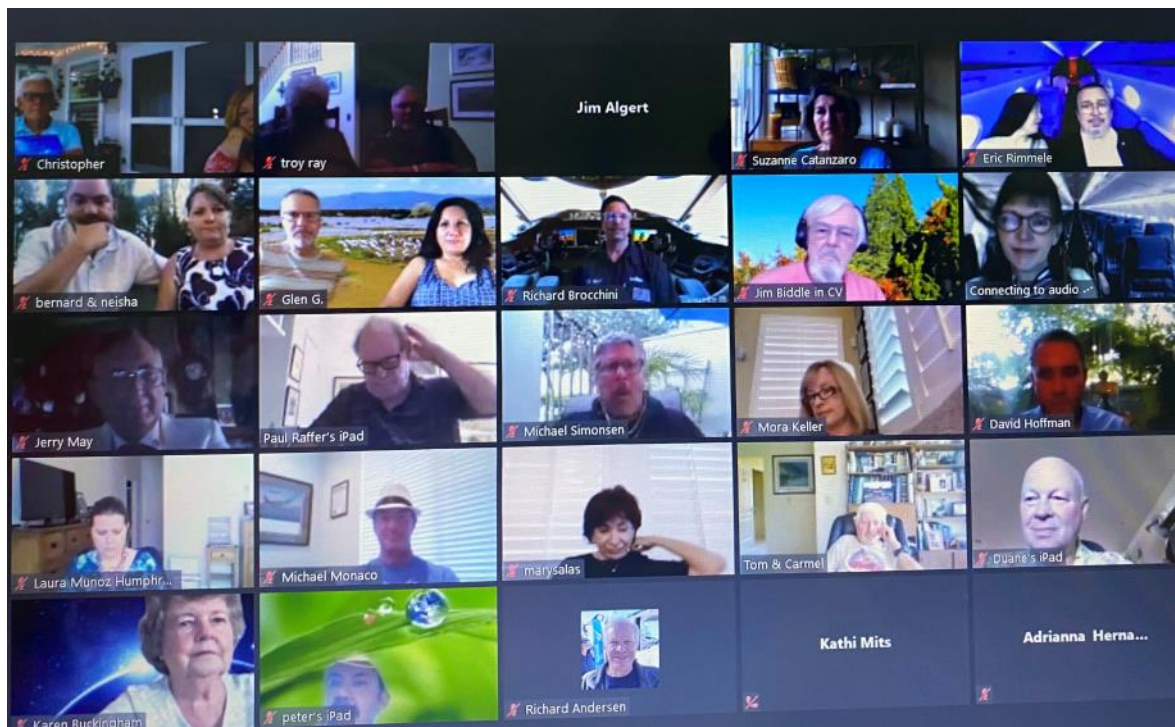
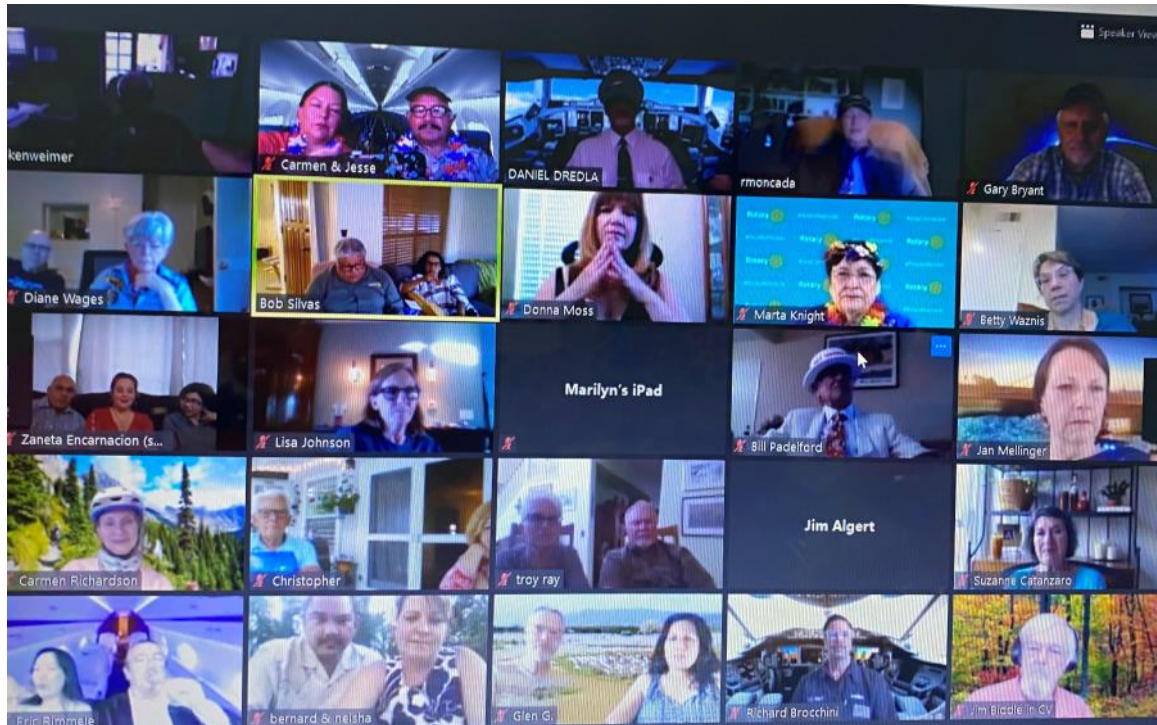
