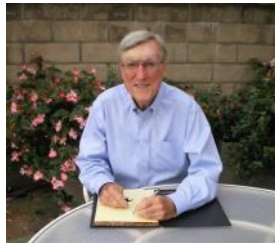

Kevin Glynn is a retired pulmonary physician with Scripps Health in La Jolla. He practiced in San Diego for 35 years, was medical director of respiratory care at Scripps Mercy Hospital, and a clinical professor of Medicine at UCSD.

A native of Chicago, he graduated from Northwestern University Medical School, and completed residency at the University of Michigan. Before coming to San Diego he was on the staff of the medical chest service at Milwaukee County General Hospital. In 2017 he published *Gasping For Air*, a book on how our breathing is killing us and what we can do about it.
