Our one-of-a-kind HomeShare program connects those who want to share their homes with others looking for alternative housing—an innovative solution to San Diego's shortage of affordable living options.

Participants include independent older adults or couples, working professionals, and students seeking reasonable housing. Shared living agreements facilitate a private bedroom and shared use of common areas in exchange for rent, household services, or a combination of both. ElderHelp maintains each agreement with ongoing support to ensure stable living environments and long-lasting relationships.

It's an opportunity to create intergenerational friendships and awareness, giving seniors a sense of security in knowing someone else is home.

Kevin Glynn gave us an in depth look at tuberculosis, especially as it is in our local area. First, TB is transmitted through the air from the cough of someone who carries the disease. Many can have the disease and not show any symptoms because their immune system fights it off. However, if the person has AIDS, HIV or other disease that weakens the protection, then TB can be debilitating. It is treatable with a 12-18 month treatment that requires close care because often the patient is in the marginalized group that has the diseases noted above or is in poverty and they either cannot afford or are unwilling to submit to the regimen of treatment.

There were 258 cases of TB in San Diego County in 2016, 75% of which involved persons from other countries.

Kevin is working to obtain a Rotary Global Grant to support building a new facility in Tijuana that will treat those with TB that do not have HIV or AIDS.
