Chief Harry Muns  
Chula Vista Fire Department  
Friday, November 5, 2021—Noon



Harry Muns was appointed Fire Chief by Chula Vista City Manager Maria Kachadoorian effective December 31, 2020. Previously, Chief Muns was the Deputy Chief, Director of Operations for the Chula Vista Fire Department.

He was responsible for all emergency operations to mitigate approximately 21,000 calls for service per year. To achieve this, fire operations deploy 14 response units out of 9 fire stations throughout the 52 square miles of the city. Harry has worked for Chula Vista Fire Department since 1996 and has filled all operational positions throughout his career.

Harry has been involved with the DHS/FEMA US&R National Response System since 1997 with California-Task Force 8. He has held the positions of Rescue Specialist, Rescue Squad Officer, Rescue Team Manager, and now is rostered as a Task Force Leader. Having filled these positions resulted in many deployments to large-scale incidents around the nation.

Chief Muns was drawn to the fire service by his desire to serve the community and the organization. He earned his Professional Studies Degree from California State University Long Beach. His favorite way to spend time with his wife Michelle and two teenagers is to take family vacations.
