## Meeting Highlights—Sept. 3, 2021

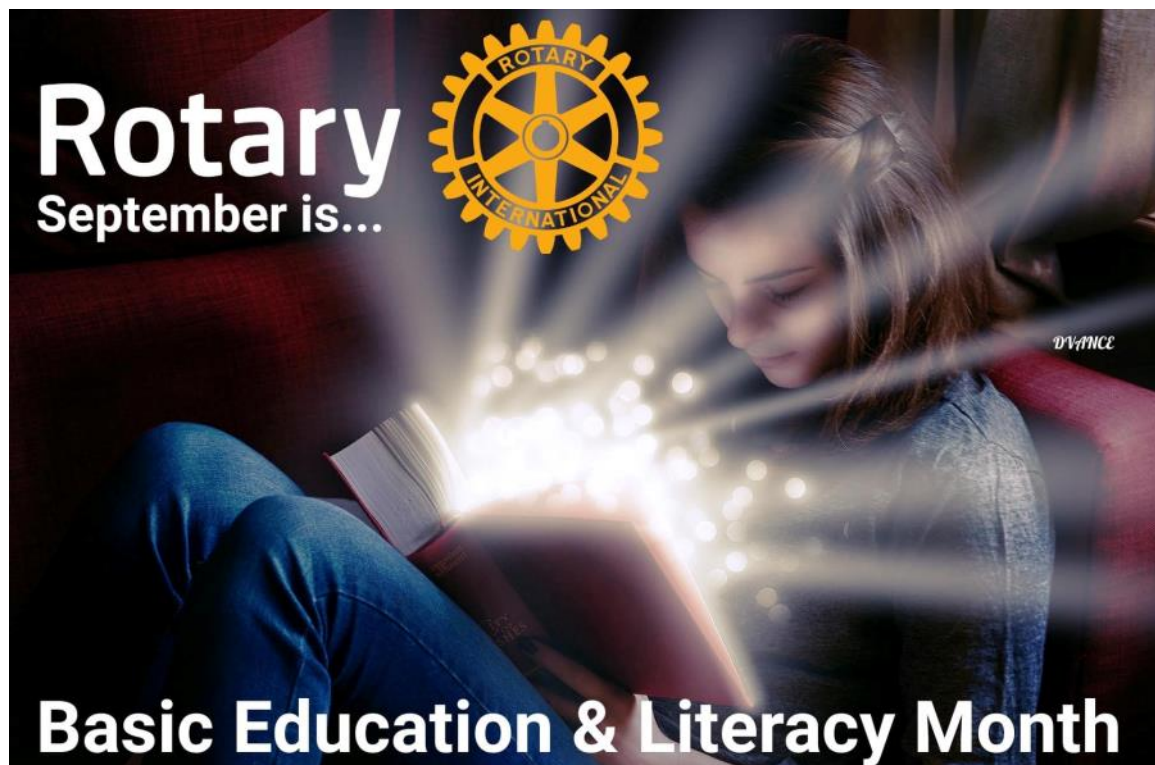
