Joey Landwehr, Tony Award Winning Artistic Director of JCompany Youth Theatre, is getting rave reviews from Rotarians with his presentation called: Random Acts of Culture, which brings underserved children from all parts of San Diego County, to experience the joy and excitement of live theater -- often for the very first time. His goal is to educate every Rotarian in San Diego about the importance of arts and culture for all children -- especially in our screen-obsessed society.

Joey Landwehr is the proud Artistic Director for JCompany Youth Theatre. Joey has won over 40 awards for his work with young artists in San Diego, including a special creativity award for shaving his head with his lead in THE KING AND I, Yul Brynner style, and raising over \$10,000 for Rady Children's Hospital's Cancer Unit - earning him the title Joey "Do Anything For The Arts" Landwehr.

Joey moved to San Diego after being a professional actor and director in New York City working on and off Broadway, national tours, regional theatre and directing and soloing at Carnegie Hall. Joey received his MFA in acting and directing from The Ohio State University.
