After retiring as a player, he became a scout, manager, and executive for various teams, including the Seattle Mariners and the San Diego Padres.

He was the first minority executive in Padre's history. As a director with the San Diego School of Baseball, along with Baseball Hall of Fame members Tony Gwynn and Alan Trammel, future HOF, Bruce Bochy, and numerous other notable names within Major League Baseball, instructed thousands of players from all over the world.

He, along with his two brothers, and three sons played professional baseball. Baseball is in fact the family business. Currently, the work continues, working as a consultant with the MLBPA with the Hank Aaron Invitational, the Swing Man Classic, and other youth directed engagements. Working with young hopeful baseball players is the greatest fulfillment and the most rewarding experience of his career.


