Hunter Heart Safe

August 31, 2022



Hunter Heart Safe are a group of local health care workers, volunteering their time to teach CPR and AED use to the community.



Shaun from Hunter Heart Safe gave an excellent AV presentation, which included an explanation of the seriousness of cardiac arrest and how important it is that the general public knows the symptoms and what to do, the principles of CPR and how to use a defibrillator (AED) which are becoming more common in public places such as shopping centres.

We then broke up into groups of 2 and practised CPR and the use of the defibrillator with the assistance of one of the Hunter Heart Safe volunteers



Kerry thanked the Hunter Heart Safe volunteers and presented Shaun with a book for signing, which will be donated to a local school.
