

Fund-a-Teen in Need



The objective of the Fund-a-Teen in Need program is to provide assistance for teens whose home support system is unable to provide the everyday necessities that being a student in today's society requires. Assistance requests can be for items as small as school supplies, on up to a scientific calculator, a pair of sneakers, a warm winter coat, or even specialty items for sports and other extracurriculars. Our goal is to never let a lack of appropriate gear hinder the learning and growing process, and for no teen to ever feel embarrassed, ashamed or left out because they are not appropriately outfitted to participate.

For those gift requests we are able to fulfill, the gift will be delivered to the requestor unless other arrangements are made. Gifts will be in discreet, plain packaging so as to not draw attention. Please note that requests should include as much detail as possible, so that the shopper can provide the best possible gift for every teen; however, <u>brand</u> <u>names should not be requested</u>. For example, women's black running shoes, size 8, is great, but we are unable to accept a request for Nike's. Some requests may be more suited to a previously owned item, i.e. if a student needs a bike to get to school or a job. That would exceed the budgetary allowance for the program if purchased new, but a used bike could be located and donated. Every effort will be made to meet the requestor's deadline, though no guarantee can be made.
