August 6	This U.S. president signed the Voting Rights Act on this day in 1965. The landmark legislation prohibited racial discrimination in voting and is thought by many to be the most effective piece of civil rights legislation ever enacted. (Hint: this president is perhaps best known by his initials, but he's not JFK)
August 13	The Battle of Warsaw began on this day in 1920, pitting this country against the U.S.S.R. The battle lasted until August 25 and the Red Army was defeated. (Hint: being located between Germany and Russia makes for a turbulent history)
August 20	This Yankee slugger hit his 23rd career grand slam on this day in 1938. His record stood for 75 years until another Yankee, Alex Rodriguez, hit his 24th on September 21, 2013. (Hint: he never pitched an inning)
August 27	This valuable commodity was discovered on this day in 1859 in Titusville, PA. (Hint: this discovery led to the world's first commercially successful oil well)

FUN FACTS ...

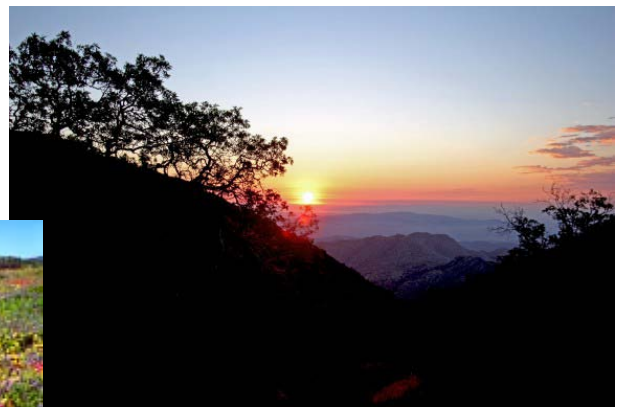
The human body is an amazing creation. Here are some little known fun facts about it ...
