<u>Our Program</u> Introduced by JANET BLEDSOE LACY JANET raised a few eyebrows when she started off the program by saying, "I am not being sexist when I say I'm going to introduce a 'HOT' policeman! ... Sgt. Jim Ridenour leads the Oceanside Police Department's Homeless Outreach Team (H.O.T.)"



This special team was created in 2014 and is comprised of two officers and a sergeant. The ultimate goal of the H.O.T. is to assist the city's homeless population in "breaking the cycle" of homelessness.



The H.O.T. works closely with several service providers to help accomplish this goal by connecting these individuals with the various resources that are available to them to assist them in finding permanent housing. There are several social workers, volunteers, and other staff that work closely with the H.O.T. officers, both in the office and out in the field. Some of the service providers they work with include: Interfaith

Community Services, Brother Benno's, Health and Human Services Association, McAlister Institute, The Regional Taskforce on The Homeless (RTFH), Mental Health Systems (MHS), Alpha Project, and the City Housing Authority. The team has adopted a "non-enforcement" approach that lends to building rapport, trust, and communication, leading to constructive relationships which then lead to problem solving.

The team holds open office hours every Thursday at 1:30 pm at the H.O.T. Office located at 307 N. Nevada Street, Oceanside. For more information on the Homeless Outreach Team (H.O.T.), contact:

H.O.T now has 2 vans (that intentionally do not look like Police Cars) that you might see around town as they help the homeless.

Unfortunately, 95% of homeless are addicts. Not all want help and because of restrictions from the court system defining specific things as "not being illegal", it can be difficult sometimes to persuade those that are homeless to get the help they need. Fortunately for Oceanside, our City understands this and we have our H.O.T. program and those involved are very well trained and educated in order to understand how they can best help those on the streets as well as other residents. We are very fortunate because many cities that are struggling with homelessness do not have such focused support from city, state, and federal officials.

Thanks to Sgt Ridenour and his team, Oceanside is showing a positive outcome when working with these individuals.
