Susan then reviewed some of the activities at the District Conference. For the program she reviewed a program "Project Peanut Butter" and showed a video. In several third world countries such as Malawi and Sierra Leona, young children are malnutrioned. Many die young. If they go to a hospital, they become infected with some germ and they have no resistance. In these countries, peanuts grow wild. When they are cultivated they produce eve better. A researcher Doctor has come up with a formula using the peanuts for a nutritional formula at low cost. It combines peanuts, with milk powder and vitamins. At \$25 enough formula can be provided to save and restore a young person. A photo was shown of a very under weight young girl. After 6 weeks another picture was shown revealing a remarkable improvement. This formula can be taken home so mothers can use it and not have tor risk taking their children to the hospital .12 months after using this product, 96% of these children are still ell nourished. This therapy is endorsed by UNICEF. The goal is to save over 2 million children by 2015.
