Rotary District High School Music Competition

Rotary Music Scholarship Competition

The Rotary Music Scholarship Competition identifies some of the finest music students in Rotary District 5340. Through this completion, Rotary encourages and supports the value of music education.

Rules for the Competition

- 1. The competition is open to High School Seniors who live and/or attend schools within the boundaries of Rotary District 5340 (San Diego County and parts of Imperial County)
- 2. The competition open to students who will continue their musical education beyond high school
- 3. The competition is limited to Instrumentalist (All musical Instruments are allowed). An accompanist may be allowed
- 4. The student must be sponsored by a District 5340 Rotary Club
- 5. The competition is open to the performance of any genre of music (Classical, Jazz, Modern, etc.) including an original composition
- 6. The performance MUST be between 5 and 8 minutes in length
- 7. The District final winner will receive cash \$2,500 scholarship. The three runner-ups in the final competition will each receive \$500
- 8. The winner will also perform at the District Conference on May 20. 2017
- 9. The Rotary Club competition will be held in January 2017. The Regional Competitions will be held in February followed by the Final Competition in March.
