During my tenure as a volunteer and then the executive director of Parrot Education and Adoption Center, I started to notice some areas in the world of animal rescue and rehoming that I felt needed to be redesigned.

Through the generosity of the Kern Trust and Foundation, I was able to leave Parrot Education and Adoption Center and develop ARC, the Avian Rehabilitation Center, through which I am able to facilitate this necessary assistance through my own design, with guidance from the ARC Board of Directors.


