What's the Scoop on Proposition L?

Greg Humora, La Mesa City Manager, was our guest speaker today addressing Proposition L on the November ballot. Humora has been an employee of the City of La Mesa for the past 24 years and the City Manager for 3 years.

HE MAGIC

The La Mesa City council voted unanimously to place an extension of the sales tax on the ballot next month. Since 2008, La Mesa has relied on local funding



from a voter-approved sales tax. With this funding set to expire the city is looking for Proposition L to extend it for another 20 years. This 3/4¢ sales tax will continue to assist the city by providing \$12 million to the local revenue. The cost is paid by both residents and visitors who shop in La Mesa. Without this funding, La Mesa will need to make significant reductions to public safety services, and the maintenance of streets, sidewalks, parks, storm drains, etc. The measure to renew this funding also requires Public disclosure of all spending and mandatory annual audits. All funds must stay in La Mesa and no funds can be taken away by the State, County or other agencies.
