Huston Glenn Kellogg, MD April 6, 1924 - October 18, 2019

Glenn Kellogg has passed on at the age of ninety five and a half, and will always be remembered for his humor and dedication to Rotary. He had near perfect attendance as a member of La Mesa Rotary for over fifty five years. His Rotary service included serving as President in 1981-82 then District Council chairman and a member of the D5340 Vaccination / Immunization team. For a time he taught first year medical students at UCSD school of medicine. Glenn was also a member of the Masonic Lodge and Al Bahr Shrine, plusthe RODEO group.(*Retired Old Doctors Eating Out*)

He was a 1947 graduate of Washington University School of medicine in St. Louis and served as a medical doctor in the Navy. Following military service he came to San Diego and became a staff physician at Grossmont Hospital when it opened in 1955. He specialized in pediatrics and was the first pediatrician to volunteer service at the Home of Guiding Hands where his challenged son Jake is a resident. An avid traveler, he admitted to have taken forty one passenger ship cruises, many with his son.

When first coming to San Diego he bought a small ranch in Mission Valley. Years later Caltrans took it for Interstate 8 and he bought a house on the rim overlooking Mission Valley. That house was destroyed in a brush fire. He then rebuilt on the site and hosted several Rotary Christmas parties over the years. Glenn and his family liked the CuyamacaMountains where they had a cabin at the Shrine camp. He was predeceased by his first wife Dorothy and is survived by their sons Jacob and Paul and his second wife Eleanor.

Newer Rotarians will remember Glenn for attending Rotary meetings week after week even though he had many health challenges, while longer time Rotarians will remember him for his service to the immunization program, Home of Guiding Hands and the Al Bahr Shrine burn program. Glenn and his off the wall humor will be missed.


