Rules of the speech:

Subject: Apply the 4-Way Test to any topic:

Is it the TRUTH? Is it FAIR to all concerned? Will it build GOODWILL and BETTER FRIENDSHIPS? Will it be BENEFICIAL to all concerned?

Delivery: Notes will be permitted at the club and sub-regional level but will be limited to only one 3x5 card at the regional finals. No notes will be permitted at the District Finals.

Length of Speech: No less than 5 minutes nor more than 7 minutes in length. Penalty points will be assessed if the speech length is outside these limits.

Speech Content: The speech given by each contestant must be original and clearly show the practical application of the Rotary 4-Way Test in the subject of the speech and the lives of the age group of the contestant, where applicable. The speech should also address either the motto of Rotary: "Service above Self" or the Rotary theme of the year. For 2020-2021 the theme is: "Rotary Opens Opportunities"!
