The Salvation Army Grant Recipient

For more than 130 years The Salvation Army has been delivering services and hope to the less fortunate in Southern California. Internationally, it is an organization with a lineage of public service that dates to 1865 and has evolved over the decades into a social service provider with an unmatched scope and breadth. The Salvation Army currently has representation in 130 different countries worldwide, in addition to nearly 8,000 centers of operation across the United States.

The Salvation Army Door of Hope helps women who are in crisis – especially those with children – return to independence by healing, developing emotionally and spiritually, and learning new skills that promote self-sufficiency. Countless women and their families have come to the Door of Hope with no home or plan, and with the help of our staff and counselors, built a new life.

The Door of Hope Transitional Living Center, a one-year residential program for homeless, single mothers and their children, provides each family with an individual apartment and assistance with education, child care, job development, pastoral counseling, and life skills classes. Last year 53 mothers and their children – 143 total people – stayed at the Transitional Living Center. Additionally, Door of Hope Haven Interim Housing provides short-term housing (3 months or less) and a safe and structured environment for single women and women with children experiencing homelessness. Last year Haven interim housing served 175 people.


