Embracing the Gift of Empathy Veronica Mussa

Veronica Musa is a lawyer and advocate from Argentina, specialized in human rights. She has worked in several countries and lectured at universities in the US, Argentina, Spain, and the Netherlands.

In the United States, she served as a human rights monitor for the Fair Food Standards Council, in charge of the implementation of the Fair Food Program, the only comprehensive corporate social responsibility program in the agricultural sector of the USA. Previously, she monitored the conditions of confinement of immigrant detainees on behalf of Florida Institutional Legal Services. Veronica has worked for the Truth, Justice, Memory Center of Istanbul, Turkey, and for the Center for Peace Studies in Bogota, Colombia.

She holds two degrees in law from Universidad Nacional de Rosario, Argentina, and an LL.M. in Comparative Law from the University of Florida. Currently, she is a Grillo-Marxuach Family/TRF Scholar at the University of San Diego.
