Helix Water District is responsible for the safety, quality and reliability of the drinking water for over half a million people in San Diego's east county. The district provides water treatment for Padre Dam, Lakeside and Otay water districts, and distributes water to the cities of La Mesa, El Cajon and Lemon Grove, the Spring Valley community and unincorporated areas of the county.

HELIX IS A SPECIAL DISTRICT

A special district is a local government agency formed by voters to perform a needed service, such as water or sewer. Most are governed by a Board elected from their communities and are effective service providers because they are held to high standards of transparency and accountability.

The requirements for a proper submission:

- Request must be accompanied with a letter from the club sponsor specifying why we should consider this request.
- A letter from the charity specifying on how they plan on utilizing the funds requested.
- The Charity must be a 501(c)(3)
- Amount of request cannot be greater than \$1,000 per fiscal year.
- Their Federal Tax Number and their California Tax Exempt number.
- The charity must be able to make an appearance at a club meeting to be presented with the donation.

The more information provided by the charitable organization on how the funds will be utilized, the more likely the better chance they have.
