Community service, with a strong emphasis on financial wellness and supporting community organizations is in the DNA of California Coast Credit Union (Cal Coast). Tommy Morales, Manager of Cal Coast's La Mesa Branch, spoke to us about how the credit union's employees are actively engaged in volunteer programs, financial education, and charitable initiatives. We met Tommy at our Urban Angels barbecue last month when he was provided education and support for the foster young adults there. Cal Coast also supports local students through scholarships and grants. Since 2015 the Cal Coast Cares Foundation has provided one million dollars in scholarships and grants to students and foster children. Cal Coast will open it's 27th branch this month in Logan Heights. The Logan Heights branch will include a financial wellness center with rooms for area businesses to hold meetings in.

Tommy also went in depth to discuss the Go Green Energy Financing and the Bite of Reality programs. The Go Green Energy Program is a program developed by the state of California to help residents finance their energy improvements. The Bite of Reality is a program where high school or college students are given real world scenarios - they must budget, spend, and save.
