Carrying on the family tradition of service, Al enlisted into the US Marine Corps in 2004 and served 5 years as a Military Police Officer and a Presidential Support Specialist responsible for safe guarding Marine One during Presidential Support Missions under the G.W. Bush Administration. After an 8 year career in Security & Law Enforcement, Al now works at San Diego Habitat for Humanity as a part of the Neighborhood Revitalization & Veteran Services Team as the Community Projects Manager serving local families.

This is a great evening of thanking and recognizing our out-going President and Board Members and for welcoming in our new President and Board Members!

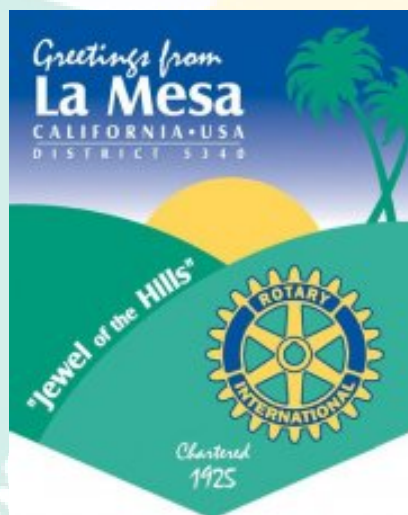
