La Mesa Climate Action Program



Hilary Ego, Environmental Manager City of La Mesa, Lainey Bloom, Community Engagement Fellow, and Logan Kelly, Transportation Fellow educated us on the City of La Mesa Climate Action Program (CAP). In March 2018, the City of La Mesa affirmed its commitment to environmental sustainability when City Council adopted CAP. CAP establishes a long-range roadmap to reduce greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions in the categories of energy, transportation, solid waste, water, and green infrastructure. These efforts help drive down harmful emissions and support La Mesa's vision of a community with a safe and healthy environment.

CAP established two community-wide greenhouse gas reduction goals:

- 50% reduction from 2016 emissions by 2035
- 85% reduction from 2016 emissions by 2045

The City has partnered with Fellows in the CivicSpark and College Corps programs to serve the City and work with the Environmental Program Manager on CAP projects including but not limited to: solid waste management, energy efficiency, community engagement, water conservation, transportation, and green infrastructure.

Lainey and Logan are two College Corps Fellows from USD that serve part time over the academic year and assist with CAP implementation.
