Presentation at Patrick Henry High School Seniors Awards Ceremony Thursday June 8<sup>th</sup>:

I am here representing the La Mesa Rotary Club presenting our Bill Kalt Rotary Kids Scholarships.

Rotary is a global network of 1.2 million neighbors, friends, leaders and problem-solvers who come together to make positive, lasting change in communities at home and abroad. Our motto is "Service Above Self" and we abide by the 4 way-test.

The La Mesa Rotary Club was founded in 1925. Our mission is to provide service to others, promote integrity, and advance world understanding, goodwill, and peace through its fellowship of business, professional, and community leaders.

I would like to thank Mr. Jim Kline for all of the work and support that he puts into this program each year!

I am very proud of our 2 seniors today! Our two recipients tonight will be the 35<sup>th</sup> & 36<sup>th</sup> recipients of this award. Each of these young ladies represents the Bill Kalt Rotary Kids Scholarships to the utmost! Each of our recipient's will receive a scholarship worth \$2,000.
