## SKYDIVING INNOVATIONS





Ron Lee, CEO and Chief Inspiration Office of Skydiving Innovations, introduced us to his entertainment company. Ron and his wife formed Skydiving Innovations an ariel entertainment company in 1986. They found a way to make a living doing something they love.

Ron emphasized, "there can be enormous value in experiencing fear, risk, stuggle and failure". He feels our steps into the realm of repeated risk-challenge helps result in the long-term outcomes we desire.

Skydiving Innovations team members have a combined total of over 250,000 skydives, and three members of their team serve as US Parachute Association (USPA) Safety and Training Advisors. Since 1986, Skydiving Innovations has planned and/or produced more than 500 events, and remains incident/accident-free. Ron, personally, has made 7300 jumps in his forty years of sky diving.

Ron showed several slides of his jumps on the USS Midway, Hotel Del and water jumps. One of his highlights was when their team had 100 jumpers over San Francisco, an operation that included several of the jumpers forming a "T" for the customer T Mobile.
