Outgoing La Mesa Rotary Foundation President Guy Elam gives the club an update on how the Foundation is working and introduces the incoming President - Tim Miller.

"The Foundation Board meets quarterly and is responsible for the money you donate to charitable giving and the raffle making these donations tax deductible. The Board also handles the dispursment of funds from our Fundraisers and money donated that needs to be held for specific purposes like the Bill Kalt Scholrships and the Lambert Awards. The Board also has final vote on all requests for our Charitable Giving Camping.

The 5 members of the Foundation Board serve 3-year terms, the president must be a past-president of La Mesa Rotary. The members of the past board were Guy Elam - President, Ron Morell - Treasurer, Sam Bauchmann - Secretary, Bill Ashman & John Carlson.

The past 3 years we have focused on developing the strategy to develop an Endowment Fund. This is complete and we now invite donations or moines designated in wills, trusts and estates. This money will be invested until we have \$100,000 invested and then, any money earned will be available to the club for local use. *Please consider the La Mesa Rotary Foundation when doing your estate planning*. This would be in addition to your Paul Harris international giving which we fully support."
